FIRST FRIDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION: Following Mass this Friday, October 6.
Exposition, Prayers to the Sacred Heart, Silent Prayer, Anointing of the Sick, Benediction.
There will be a brief pause after Mass to allow those who are not staying for the prayer service to depart. When the Eucharist is exposed in the Monstrance all attention and due reverence should be given to our Lord's Real Presence on the altar. This means absolutely no talking when the Eucharist is exposed in the church and kneeling (if you are physically able) during the period of exposition.
