The Father Jim Naughton Scholarship

During his many years as Pastor of St. Theresa, Fr. Jim set aside funds from several personal sources, including a portion of his pay and other monies given to him, or on his behalf. Before leaving for his Eternal Reward, he requested that the monies be used for the youth of the Parish; and hence this Annual Scholarship program was established. The scholarship is open to all registered youth of St. Theresa entering grades 6 - 12 in a Catholic School, Institution, or Homeschool Program for the school-year 2019-2020. Students are judged according to grade level, and up to three \$500 awards will be made. Application forms and criteria are available at the Parish Office. The deadline to return all documents is Noon on Monday, June 3, 2019. Awards are for one year at a time, but previous winners may re-apply in subsequent years.
