The scholarship is open to all registered youth of St. Theresa entering grades 6 – 12 in a Catholic School, Institution, or Homeschool Program for the school-year 2019-2020. Students are judged according to grade level; and up to three \$500 awards will be made. Application forms and criteria are available at the Parish Office. The deadline to return all documents is Noon on Monday, June 3, 2019. Awards are for one year at a time, but previous winners may re-apply in subsequent years.*
