Parish-Wide Consecration to Mary

Our Parish would like to provide the 33 Days to Morning Glory Retreat beginning on Wednesday, September 4 to October 7. What's involved? Daily readings from the 33 Days to Morning Glory book (the daily readings are very short), a weekly meeting which will last approximately 1.5 hours (includes prayer time, video and group discussion) and on the final day, our consecration to Mary! Is there a cost for the retreat? Yes, the cost is a bit under \$30. This includes the materials participants use during the retreat, including the book, retreat guide, prayer cards, miraculous medal, rosary, and a Consecration Day Certificate. Who can better lead us to Jesus than His beautiful mother, Mary? If you would like to make this spiritual consecration, there is a sign-up sheet in the vestibule.

We will meet on Sundays from 4-5:30 p.m. in the library at the Parish Hall beginning on Sunday, September 1 through and including Sunday, October 6.
