DECEMBER 1ST 2021 | DOBBS V JACKSON SUPREME COURT CASE

- On January 22, 1973: abortion was made legal in the United States by the Supreme Court's decision on the Roe v Wade case.
- In 2018: Mississippi passed a law protecting unborn children after 15 weeks of gestation, when the baby has a heartbeat, eyes that open, ears that hear, and can move and kick.
- The law was challenged and the case, known as <u>Dobbs v Jackson</u>, is being heard by the Supreme Court.
 - Dobbs v Jackson is a landmark case that could potentially overturn the decision of Roe v Wade.
- On December 1, 2021 oral arguments for the case will be heard. A decision is expected in June 2022.
