Why do you Catholics call your priests, "father" when the Bible says "call no man on earth your father"? The Bible says Jesus had brothers and sisters, why does the Catholic Church teach He didn't? Where is Purgatory in the Bible? Why do you pray to Mary? Where is that in the Bible?

Have you ever been asked questions like these by well-meaning, or sometimes not so well-meaning friends, family members, co-workers, or fellow students? Would you like to know how to not only answer those questions, but be able to turn those questions around and use those situations to evangelize others and to plant seeds of the Catholic Faith?
