Q: What differentiates a Catholic marriage from a secular one?

A: The basic answer is that a Catholic marriage is a sacrament, a secular marriage is not. Or, to put it another way, a Catholic marriage is a covenant...an exchange of persons...while a secular marriage is more akin to a contract. A covenant cannot be broken, a contract can be. In a Catholic marriage, a sacramental marriage, the couple receive grace from God through the sacrament that they do not receive in a secular marriage. "This grace proper to the sacrament of Matrimony is intended to perfect the couple's love and to strengthen their indissoluble unity. By this grace they 'help one another to attain holiness in their married life and in welcoming and educating their children.'" (Catechism, #1641).
