PSR (Parish School of Religion) - Every Sunday, 9:00 am to 10:15 am during the school year.


Confirmation - Classes and parent meetings are announced in the bulletin.

Some of our groups and ministries to serve your spiritual needs:

MOMS - Ministry of Mothers Sharing - Mothers of young children meet twice monthly with their children to pray and share experiences to grow spiritually in the vocation of holy motherhood (usually with humor).

Young & Young at Heart Adult Gathering - Periodic meetings of parish adults for fellowship, fun, and food.

Teens Reaching Out! - Teens looking to hang out with their friends while worshiping and growing in the Catholic Faith.

Adult Bible Study - Study the biblical text and the Church's guidelines for understanding the Bible.

Catholic Scripture Study - Learn more about the Sacred Scriptures as they relate to the Catholic faith - - and how they sometimes differ from our non-Catholic brethren.

Ministry of Hospitalization - Providing meals for parishioners who are sick, and after hospitalization.

Ministry for Bereavement – Groups of volunteers bring meals to the parish hall for families of parishioners after a funeral mass and burial.

Homebound Visitation - Sister Rita visits parishioners who are homebound or in the hospital.

Leeds Welfare Cooperative - Helping the less fortunate in the Leeds area.

Breakfast & Friendships - Enjoy breakfast with your church friends after the Wednesday morning mass at Laney's Restaurant in Leeds.
